PSG COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY UG EXAMINATION HALL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Candidates must be seated half an hour before the examination and strictly not allowed after that time.
- Candidates must be present in the examination hall on time and remain collected until the answer sheets are collected and declared disperse.
- 3. Candidates are not permitted to enter the examination hall with overcoat's and shirts tucked in.
- 4. Candidates must maintain their hall tickets in a good condition and bring it along for every exam without fail.
- 5. In case of missed hall ticket's, candidates must pay Rs.250 to obtain a duplicate.
- 6. Students must not be wearing boots, rings, flowers, mehendhi, anklets, dangling earrings, nail polish.
- 7. Candidates are permitted to wear sandals alone (hawai slippers, rubber slippers are not allowed) inside the examination hall for internal and university theory examinations.
- 8. Candidates are permitted to wear sandals alone for the practical exams only on the day of internal theory exams. For university practical exams boy's must wear black shoes and socks and girls must wear black sandals.
- 9. Calculators, digital diaries, mobile phones, hand pouches, colour pencil boxes, printed materials and notes are strictly prohibited. Possession of these by the candidate shall entail cancellation of the examination for that candidate and also liable for disciplinary condition.
- 10. Answers must be written legibly in blue /black ink or ball point pen.
- 11. Candidates should ascertain the date, examination hall number from the notice board/respective staff in-charge's.
- 12. Boys must precent with neatly shaved face and proper hair cut.
- 13. Girls must not leave their hair loose, which must be kept braided
- 14. Boys must use only black belt for fastening.
